# Sus2 and Sus4

Diagrammatic representation of chords on a treble clef staff:

- A**: Standard A major chord (E2, C#3, E3, G3, A3, C#4).
- A (sus4)**: A major suspended 4th chord (E2, A3, C#4, E4).
- A (sus2)**: A major suspended 2nd chord (A2, C#3, E3, G3).
- C (sus2)**: C major suspended 2nd chord (C3, E3, G3, A3).

## Fingering
